Award Information



- The NIH, via support from the FDA Center for Tobacco Products (CTP), intends to fund approximately 10 applications, totaling up to \$1.5 million for FY2016
- Applicants may request up to \$75,000 **direct costs**, per budget year
- Applicants may request a project period of up to **2** years
- **NOTE:** Foreign institutions and non-domestic components of US organizations **are not** eligible to apply. Foreign components **are not** allowable

- The following dates are based on this RFA's cited Scientific Merit and Advisory Council Review dates:
 - Letters of Intent are due: **01/04/16, 06/30/16, & 01/05/17**
 - Application due dates: **02/23/16, 07/20/16, & 02/23/17**
 - Earliest possible start dates: **04/16, 09/16, 04/17, & 09/17**
- Awards will include a special term, requiring a **separate interim progress** report at the six month portion of each budget year
- Reminders:
 - FDA-funded awards **do not** have carryover authority; therefore, a prior approval request must be submitted for situations where there is a bona fide need
